- Established the Nepean Amateur Basketball Association, a grassroots organization that remained sustainable for more than 25 years.
- Credited for being the driving force behind the establishment of Ontario Basketball's Player Development Program. She organized the first Junior Development program in 1976 and the first Midget Development Program in 1978.
- Hazel was a Board member of Ontario Basketball from 1972-1987
- Organized summer basketball camps in Ottawa that were participated in by thousands of youth over the years.
- Organized overseas trips for the Ottawa Rookies club.
- Managed teams that won five consecutive Ontario Basketball championships from 1984-1988.
- Facilitated the development of countless athletes that have gone on to success on the National and Junior National level.
- The Hazel Miner Award given to members of Ontario Basketball's U15 and U17 Provincial teams who uphold the "Finest Qualities of Sport, in their Pursuit of Athletic Excellence."
