Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Working with Clubs & Competitions staff to plan and organize the 2023 OBA Championships, including liaising with host clubs, and assembling Championships host packages for host committees (e.g. signage, merchandise, rulebooks, basketballs).
- Supporting the generation of digital content for OBL on the OBA website and OBA social media channels.
- Supporting OBL staff with schedules, standings, and rankings.
- Performing other related tasks as assigned.
